Supplies for 1st class

- *3 ring notebook, pencil*
- *scissors, paper scissors and 3" or 4" embroidery scissors (sharp to the point)*
- *Needles, sharps #11 or #12 and/or milliners or straw #11*
- *thread (cotton size 50/60); threads will be added as needed.*
- *Supplies and fabric for future classes will be discussed at this first class.*

Techniques that will be learned or improved:

- Background fabric layout and cutting instructions
- Picking out fabric for your blocks
- Papercut design
- Papercut placement
- Pattern transfer
- Appliqué hidden stitches
- Smooth valleys and sharp points
