CURVED LOG CABIN SUPPLIES

The Log Cabin Quilt Block is one of those perfect blocks. Once mastered, you can't stop there because it is almost impossible to run out of ways to make unique log cabin quilts. It's ideal for strip piecing and perfectly suited for using up scraps. The Curved Log Cabin Quilt is a unique take on this traditional block. This stunning quilt is made with one repeating block using 2 1/2" strips and 1 1/2" strips.

Whether you are a confident beginner or an experienced quilter, this class will bring out a sense of adventure and endless creative possibilities as you learn how to mix fabrics with gorgeous results. This quilt finishes at 79" X 79" and is so much fun to make that you'll probably want to make another one!

Supplies:

- Simple Joys pattern by Missouri Star Quilt Co. (PPnQ will have patterns in stock)
- Basic sewing supplies
- Sewing machine, cord, foot pedal, 1/4" foot (have working knowledge of your machine)
- Rotary cutter and cutting mat (at least 12" X 18")
- Clear ruler with 1/4" measurements (at least 12" long)
- Thread for your machine and a pre-wound bobbin (neutral thread colors work best for piecing)
- Fabric scissors
- Seam ripper
- Glass head pins/pincushion
- Spray starch (optional)

Fabric:

- (1) Jelly Roll of your choice **OR** 42 - 2 1/2" X 42" pre-cut strips
- (1) Roll of 1 1/2" solid strips **OR** 1 2/3 yard background (if you purchase yardage, please cut 40 - 1 1/2" X 42" strips prior to class)
- 1/2 yard inner border fabric
- 1 1/2 yards fabric for outer border
- 3/4 yard fabric for binding
- 7 1/2 yards fabric for backing

*2 1/2" X 42" strips can come in the form of scraps from your scrap bin, fat quarters, 1/8th yard cuts or jelly rolls.
