



Painted Pony 'n Quilts
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Jelly Roll Rug class

Taught by Mechelle Buckles

The class project is a small rug (approx. 21 ½" x 13 ½")

Supplies

Jelly Roll Rug pattern

Sewing Machine (w/zig zag stitch)

Pins

Scissors

1 Jelly roll

OR scraps to equal 10 strips* of 2 ½" x width of fabric (wof)

*(10 strips is what is needed to make the small class project.)

If you choose to make the larger 30" x 44" area rug as shown in the pattern, you will use the full jelly roll (40-42 strips), as well as additional batting as noted below.

(You may not complete the 30" x 44" rug in the class time allotted, but you can continue at home to finish.)

Thread with 5 bobbins (coordinating color)

Batting: 1 roll - 2 ½" x 25 yds **OR** 100% cotton batting scraps cut into 2 ½" strips (length of all scrap strips should equal approx. 400" for the small class project)

If you are making the larger rug, you will need (2) 25 yd batting rolls.

Best Press starch

Machine needles #15

6 ½" ruler

General marking pen or pencil

BEFORE CLASS:

Please piece your fabric strips together into one long strip, according to the pattern.

If using batting scrap strips, sew strips together end to end using zigzag stitch.
