Supply List

Intermediate Machine Quilting with Walking Foot

Taught by Jo Lynn O'Neil

Sewing Machine with a walking foot

80/12 machine needle

Thread

Thread Snips

Ripper

Marking tools-blue erasable pen, chalk, etc.

1" Pins for basting

Stencils - only if you have something you need help with

Blue or green painters tape, about 1" to 2" width

12 squares of muslin (about 14")

6 squares of batting (about 14") - this is the perfect opportunity to try different types of batting that you might want to use in a future quilt

Bring a quilt top or fabric panel for a group discussion of how you could quilt it using your walking foot.

Pen and paper to take notes.

We will learn advanced techniques including different shapes like triangles, hexies, spirals and diamonds. I will also quickly demonstrate how to connect squares using a quilt-as-you-go method.
