## EASY PEASY

Come and have fun making a small wall hanging picturing pea pods and tendrils with 3-D elements. We will be using the Blooming Template sets from Black Cat Creations so cutting is done with your rotary cutter. Minay Sirois will guide you in making the elements, placing the vines and letting your artistic self out to play. It's really easy-peasy!

### Supply List

5/8 yard background –using chalk, mark with a 20-1/2" x 28-1/2" rectangle for center of wall hanging. You will trim after doing some work so the edges don't fray away.

3/4 yard green for tendrils, leaf, peas

6" x 10" rectangle dark green for inside of open pea pod

1/4 yard or 1 FQ green for pea pod caps

1/3 yard for closed pea pod and inner border

1 green FQ for open pea pod

1 green FQ for darker leaf

3/4 yard for border and binding

7/8 yard for back

Crib size cotton or cotton/poly batting – will also use this for padding leaves, pea pods, peas

\*Rotary cutter, ruler and mat

\*NOTE: a smaller rotary cutter (**28mm**) is better for cutting around the templates and a smallish (10" x 16" or so) mat or rotating mat will also help since turning the mat makes cutting the shapes easier.

Blooming Template and the Small Blooming Template Combo (this contains the Baby Bloomer and the large leaf templates)

Fabric grippers of some kind for the back of the templates – sandpaper dots, non-slip film, etc.

Sewing machine and attendant parts – don't forget your power cord and foot pedal

Regular sewing supplies – scissors, seam ripper, thread, pins, marking pencils, hand sewing needle, etc.

NOTE: You will use green thread to do top stitching on the leaves, pea pods, etc.

Washable glue stick

Washcloth – for wiping glue off fingers – damp and in a baggie is best
