LET'S TRIM A TALL TREE – Beginner Paper Piecing Class

It's time to start thinking about Christmas again. Do you really want to get out the Christmas tree? Here is your chance to learn paper piecing and make a tall Christmas tree to hang on the wall. It doesn't take up any floor space and is fun to make!

Note: if you're brand new to this process, you might consider the smaller version pattern "A Little Bit Shorter Tall Tree". This project does not involve as much piecing and may be quicker to finish. Both patterns include foundation papers to make two tree quilts.

Requirements:

- ❖ Tall Trim the Tree Pattern - 77" tall (or A little Bit Shorter Tall Tree pattern – 41" tall: *see pattern for fabric requirements*)
- ❖ Basic sewing supplies including sewing machine, thread and bobbin, rotary cutter, and cutting mat, scissors for cutting pattern, etc
- ❖ Add-a-Quarter ruler is essential
- ❖ Glue stick – SewLine recommended
- ❖ Please have fabrics chosen and purchased before class day

Fabrics:

Dark green – 1 ¼ yds

Lime green – ½ yd

Light green – ¾ yd

Medium green – ½ yd

White print – 1 yd

White – 5/8 yd

Cream – 5/8 yd

Red – ¼ yd

Brown – scrap for tree trunk

Binding – ½ yd

Optional: (25) Buttons ¾"
