

LET'S TRIM A TALL TREE

It's time to start thinking about Christmas again. Do you really want to get out the Christmas tree? This is your chance to make a 76 ¾" Christmas tree which hangs on the wall. It doesn't take up any floor space and is fun to make.

This tree is paper pieced complete with tree skirt. If you have never taken a paper piecing class, you will probably want to take that class first. We will review paper piecing, but the whole process will not be taught in detail.

Requirements:

- Trim the Tree Pattern (will be available at PPnQ)
- Basic sewing supplies including sewing machine, rotary cutter, and cutting mat. An Add-a-Quarter ruler is essential.

Fabrics:

Dark green - 1 1/4 yds

Lime green -1/2 yd

Light green – 3/4 yd

Medium green − ½ yd

White print – 1 yd

White – 5/8 yd

Cream – 5/8 yd

 $Red - \frac{1}{4}yd$

Brown – scrap for tree trunk

Binding - ½ yd

Optional: (25) Buttons 3/4"

A fabric kit may be available for this project. There is not a regular class discount on a kit, but the pattern will be discounted.
