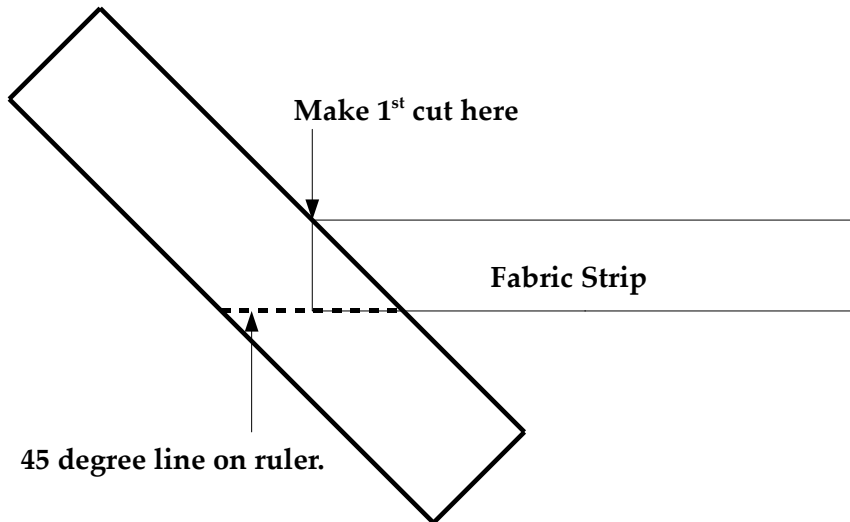


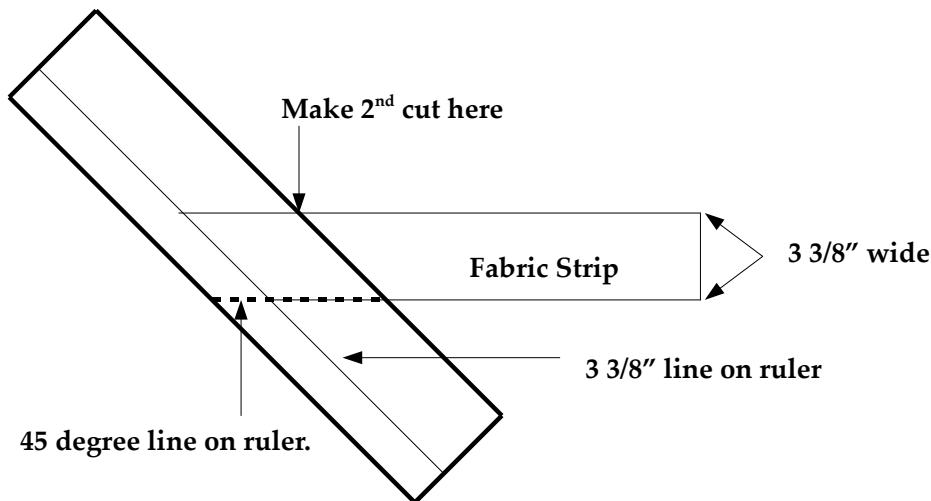
## Instructions for Cutting Easy Eight Diamonds with a Standard Ruler:

With A Standard Ruler:

If you are not using the Easy 8 ruler you can cut these by using any ruler with a 45 degree line. Follow the instructions in the diagrams below. The measurements given are those required for this project but can be substituted with any number based upon the width of your strip.



**Step 1:** Place the 45 degree line on the bottom of your fabric strip and line up the edge of the ruler with the corner. Make your first cut as shown. This will give you the initial 45 degree angle needed to start cutting your diamonds.



**Step 2:** Making sure the 45 degree line STAYS in place, slide your ruler over until you reach the 3 3/8" mark. Cut your fabric along the edge of the ruler. Repeat this step until you have the desired number of diamonds from each fabric.

These diagrams are for cutting with the right hand. If you are left handed just reverse the cutting angle.
