




## VINTAGE MEMORIES

### FIFTH BORDER - SQUARE-IN-A-SQUARE BLOCKS

From background fabric:

Cut 22 - 6 1/8"  (A)

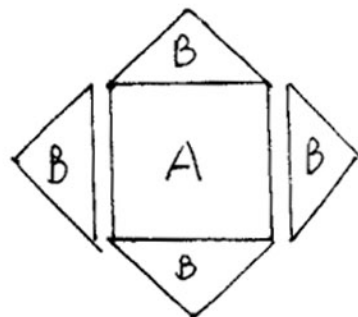
From assorted print fabrics:

Cut 22 - 6 7/8"  Re-cut  (B)

Sew a B to top and bottom of A. Then sew a B to each side to make one block.

The block should measure 8 1/2" x 8 1/2" unfinished.


Repeat for a total of 22 blocks.





DO NOT ADD THEM TO THE QUILT TOP UNTIL the filler blocks and the basket blocks are completed.


### FIFTH BORDER - FILLER BLOCKS (small square-in-a-square blocks with side rectangles) - you will make two.

From background fabric:

Cut 2 - 3 3/8"  (A)


From print fabric #1:

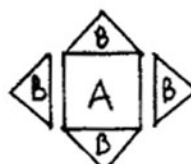
Cut 1 - 4 1/8"  Re-cut  (B)

Cut 2 - 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"  (C)

From print fabric #2:

Cut 1 - 4 1/8"  Re-cut  (B)

Cut 2 - 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"  (C)



Sew a B to top and bottom of A. Then sew a B to each side to make a square-in-a-square block. Add a rectangle to each side of square-in-a-square to make 1 filler block. (B and C is same fabric in each block). Repeat for second filler block using a different fabric. The block should measure 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" unfinished. These will be added to the center of each side border when assembling the outer border.
